You MUST ATTACH A DRAWING that shows where the fence is going to be located on the described property. Drawing should show distances from property lines, sidewalks, all structures on said property, and gate placement for access to utility meters.

8.3- FENCES

Fences may be erected to a height not to exceed six (6) feet on any part of a lot or premises other than the required front yard, provided no fences shall be erected within the triangular area required for sight distance of vehicles entering or exiting the property or entering any adjacent intersection. The height of a fence shall be determined by a measurement from the ground beneath the fence to the top of the highest part of the fence. Manmade earth berms, terraces, and retaining walls that elevate the fence shall be considered a part of the fence. It is not intended that any structure other than a fence is permitted on any part of a lot or premises by this section, and all other structures must comply with these regulations.

- 1. Property lines and fence placement must be flagged prior to submitting the application for a fence permit.
- 2. No fence erected in a required front yard shall materially obstruct public view. Permitted types of fences shall include split rail, chain link, or other similar material.
- 3. No fence shall be constructed in such a manner or be of such design as to be hazardous or dangerous to persons or animals by intent of its construction or by inadequate maintenance.
- 4. No fence shall be constructed in a designated floodway unless the fence is elevated to or above the flood height, or adequate openings are provided. Fencing and walls in floodplains require a Floodplain Development Permit.
- 5. No fence shall be constructed in such a manner that would prohibit access to water and electric meters to the employees of the City of Randolph.
