

## City of Randolph Planning Commission Minutes February 3rd, 2020

The City of Randolph Planning Commission convened in open session in the council chambers at 6:30pm.

Chairman Schmidt advised those present of the Open Meetings Act as well as locations/methods for advertisement of meeting.

Roll call from members present were Tom Guenther, Brent Billerbeck, Chad Winkelbauer, Jason Schmidt, and Josh Rayford. Absent were Dennis Bazata and Broc Eledge. Also present were Mayor George Bradley, City Administrator Benjamin Benton, City Attorney Keelan Holloway, and Reporter for the Randolph Times.

Public Hearing was opened at 6:32 Schmidt read proposed amendments to Article 7, Section 7.1, Traffic Visibility and Article 8, Section 8.5, Recreational Vehicles, Trailers, or Equipment. No one from the public provided input in favor or against. Public Hearing was closed at 6:48.

Discussion on language of amendments to 7.1 discovered further review was needed on possible re-clarifying the site triangle map along with more detail and description of different street type classifications.

Motion made by Billerbeck to Table proposed amendments to Article 7, Section 7.1, Traffic Visibility. Seconded by Rayford. All in favor were Billerbeck, Rayford, Guenther, Schmidt, Winkelbauer. None opposed.

Motion made by Winkelbauer to recommend approval or amendments to Article 8, Section 8.5, Recreational Vehicles, Trailers, or Equipment, to the City Council was seconded by Billerbeck. All in favor were Schmidt, Guenther, Rayford, Winkelbauer, and Billerbeck. Opposed - None

Other discussion was had in regards to traffic visibility in the downtown district. Brent Billerbeck agreed to take pictures of different higher traffic corners for future discussion.

Next meeting was scheduled for March 31st, 2020.

Motion to Adjourn made by Guenther and Seconded by Winkelbauer. In favor were Rayford, Schmidt, Winkelbauer, Guenther, Billerbeck. None were opposed.
