

**APPLICATION FOR SIDEWALK RENOVATION**

RESOLUTION 2023-02

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CITY OF RANDOLPH MULTI-YEAR VOLUNTEER SIDEWALK RENOVATION PROJECT AND TERMS OF THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the City of Randolph desires to establish a sidewalk renovation project which will incentivize and encourage the repair and renovation of sidewalks throughout the City of Randolph.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Randolph, Nebraska, that the City of Randolph Multi-Year Volunteer Sidewalk Renovation Project be hereby established and administered in accordance with the terms and provisions of the attached Exhibit A.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Randolph, Cedar County, Nebraska at their regular meeting held on the 3rd day of January 11, 2023.

CITY OF RANDOLPH MULTI-YEAR VOLUNTEER SIDEWALK RENOVATION PROJECT-2023

- City Council budgeted \$25,000 for fiscal year 2023 for multi-year volunteer sidewalk renovation to promote contiguous safe sidewalks within corporate limit; funds are eligible until spent
- Property owners will submit signed Sidewalk Renovation form in person at City Administration building, 212 E Broadway St, Randolph, NE 68771 January 2023-September 2023;
- Project includes replacing existing sidewalks in need of repair and curb cut to allow ramp access from street to sidewalk.
- Property owners will source their own vendor to complete work; clean concrete will be accepted at E Kemp St Recycling Center free of charge.
- All work completed will follow Ordinance 717 City Code 95.039 to complete renovation of property public sidewalk;
- All work completed will be inspected by Randolph Public Works Department;
- Property owner will submit associated receipts upon completion for reimbursement;
- Property owner is eligible for up to 50% reimbursement; up to \$5,000 per property
- Corner lot property owners qualify for same 50% reimbursement; up to \$5,000 per property
- Any work beyond the scope of Ordinance 717 are not eligible for reimbursement;
- Sidewalk renovations that are not compliant with Ordinance 717 City Code 95.039 are subject to penalty 10.99 (A) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this city code, unless otherwise specifically provided herein, shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$500. A new violation shall be deemed to have been committed every 24 hours of failure to comply with the provisions of this code.

- Any work completed that is in violation of Ordinance 717 Sidewalk Spec City Code 95.039 (D) is not eligible for 50% reimbursement and is subject to penalty 10.99: (A) Any person who violates any of the provisions of this city code, unless otherwise specifically provided herein, shall be deemed guilty of an offense and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not exceeding \$500. A new violation shall be deemed to have been committed every 24 hours of failure to comply with the provisions of this code.

**ORDINANCE 717 SIDEWALK SPEC CITY CODE 95.039 (D):**

1. Width shall be 48" wide;
  2. Reinforcement shall be at least 3-parallel #4 rebar;
  3. Concrete must be a minimum of 4000 psi;
  4. Saw joints shall be between 4 feet and 6 feet apart;
  5. Sidewalks must have a ¼" radius edge;
  6. Sidewalk must be at least 4" thick and least 6" thick on portions abutting or forming part of a driveway;
  7. Sidewalk must have a broom finish texture;
  8. Sidewalk cross slope cannot be greater than 2%;
  9. Sidewalks must have a curb cut at all streets 1' wider than the sidewalk centered on the sidewalk.
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
